Annually, the New Jersey Department of Education requires all schools to complete a HIB self-assessment. The purpose of this assessment is to grade each public school and the school district's efforts in implementing the Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Act (ABR) during that school year. Under the Commissioner's Program, each school's grade is a raw score of data and the sum of the ratings for all indicators within each core element on the School Self-Assessment (ex: 70 of 78 points). The maximum total score for a school is 78 points.
