With great concern for the health and safety of all members of our MCSSSD family, and an abundance of caution, this letter is to inform you that MCSSSD will NOT be opening on January 19th as initially planned. Reopening is now planned for Monday, April 19, 2021. We understand the disappointment associated with this news. Please understand that we will continue to monitor local health data. Please go to our district website at www.mcsssd.info for additional information.

We understand the level of concern regarding COVID-19. We encourage parents and students to continue following the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention promoted safeguards, such as:

- Staying home when you are sick;
- Washing hands often with soap for at least 20 seconds;
- Covering coughs and sneezes and properly disposing of tissues;
- Limiting close contact with people who are sick and not sharing food, drinks and utensils;
- Practicing social distancing (staying at least 6 feet apart);
- Wearing a face covering while in school; and
- Continuing to monitor your health for symptoms.

As always, we appreciate our community's support and cooperation. You can assist us by remaining vigilant but sensible in your approach to dealing with this health concern.
