

Meal Information 2021-2022 School Year

Mercer County Special Services School District will be participating in the National School Lunch Program's Seamless Summer Option (SSO) to provide free meals (Breakfast and Lunch) for all students during the 2021-2022 academic school year.

Even though the district is providing free meals to all students throughout the 2021-2022 school year, the Application for Free and Reduced-Price School Meals is still available and is used to determine eligibility for P-EBT benefits, state funding, and meal status eligibility for the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year.

All meal options will be prepackaged, individually wrapped, and distributed in closed containers. Condiments and plastic ware will all be individually wrapped and sealed.

Meals will be consumed in the student's classroom. Students will be encouraged to social distance during meals to the greatest extent possible.

Cafeteria staff will use a tally sheet to collect meal counts, no student will need to use a swipe card.

Snacks and a la carte will NOT be offered as they will not be included for free.
