You were previously notified that the Mercer County Special Services School District would be closed until March 27th. However, recently, Governor Phil Murphy issued an Executive Order closing schools indefinitely. In compliance with the directive, the Mercer County Special Services School District will be closed through April 19, 2020, pending approval from the Governor to reopen.

Be advised that our food service operations will continue. Grab and Go, Breakfast and Lunch meals, can be picked up Monday and Thursday from Mercer High School, between the hours of 11:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Please note that we will not be distributing food during the regularly scheduled spring break (April 13 to 17). Three meals will be provided during the Thursday, April 9th distribution.

Due to school closures, we must continue our transition to virtual learning. Teachers and staff will continue providing new lessons and resources through the District's website and our other digital platforms.
